

### CLL – Communication, Language and Literacy

- Listening to a range of Dinosaur Stories
- Learn, sing and recite Dinosaur rhymes and Songs
- Use non-fiction books to find out facts about Dinosaurs and to explore fossils
- Make up Dinosaur stories using Dinosaur Small World Area
- Write dinosaur fact booklets



### PD – Physical Development

- Children will develop gross motor skills by experimenting with different ways of moving, jumping, walking and running.
- Children will develop their fine motor skills by using simple tools to effect changes to materials.
- They will also continue to practise forming recognisable letters and words.
- Children will develop good practices with regard to self-care, hygiene, eating and exercising.

### PSED – Personal, Social and Emotional Development


- The children will continue to explore and explain their feelings in a safe and nurturing environment that will allow their self-confidence to bloom.
- They will be encouraged to be more independent (coming into school through the main entrance now) and to be responsible for their belongings and safe keeping of these.
- Children will carry on building relationships with each other and playing harmoniously and co-operatively.
- They will look at dinosaur teeth and compare them with their own, how to care for their teeth.



# Dinosaur Roar Spring Term 1 2022

### M – Mathematics

- The children will learn to count beyond 5 and recognise the numerals 7, 8, 9, and 10.
- They will continue to recognise different representations of the numbers up to 5 and to understand that even if the order or arrangement changes, the number stays the same (subitising).
- They will have the opportunity to combine two groups to find out how many altogether using the part-whole model to help them.



- The children will also be measuring lengths, heights and distances too.

### UW- Understanding the World

- The children will begin to have an understanding of what history and the past is as they learn that dinosaurs lived long ago.
- The children will begin to use simple software on the laptops and continue to use the ipads and programmable toys
- In R.E the children will be learning about how different religions and cultures celebrate New Year (China and Persia.) They will also learnt about the Hindu celebration of Holi.



### EAD – Expressive Arts and Design

Children will have many opportunities to explore their creativity by:

- Exploring and using different instruments
- Singing songs, listening and responding to music.
- Using and combining different media such as paper, card, playdough, clay and more.
- Constructing using different materials.
- Creating dinosaur crafts, paintings and models.
- The children will also be encouraged to use their imaginations when role-playing.
